

FUELING THE FAFSA AT YOUR SCHOOL



AT-A-GLANCE

AUGUST - SEPTEMBER

- Distribute information to students and families on how to make FSAID and what they need to complete the FAFSA
- Discuss with students how financial aid can create postsecondary opportunities

OCTOBER 1 - FAFSA FILING OPEN! FILE EARLY, STATE FUNDING CAN RUN OUT.

- Host a FAFSA event with help from ImpactTulsa
- Send out reminders to students and families via text and email

NOVEMBER - DECEMBER

- Check the OK-FDP to see who completed and who did not (once every two weeks) [okhighered.org](https://www.okhighered.org/fafsaweb/Reports/Summary) (FOR HYPERLINK ONLINE: <https://www.okhighered.org/fafsaweb/Reports/Summary>)
- Look at which of your students submitted but did not complete (missing something)
- Which of your completed students are flagged for verification? Email/message to let them know to be on the lookout for further steps from college. Let them know it is not because they did anything wrong.

JANUARY

- Hold a meeting with students who did not complete their FAFSA and see what their intentions are (unsure if pursuing postsecondary, struggling to get everything from family, trouble filing, etc.?)

SPRING SEMESTER

- Continue to encourage students to **GET OFF THEIR FAFSA!**
